

## CHECKLIST

### Required:

- Completed nomination form
- Written summary describing why nominee should be selected (minimum of 100 words)
- Picture only of the nominee (pictures will be returned only by request)
- Resume - please include education
- Letters of recommendation (at least 3)
- Articles from newspapers and magazines, mentions in bulletins, awards received, etc.
- Involvement in local and Jewish community boards and/or committees outside of professional career such as volunteer activities
- Family Information: partners, children, grandchildren
- Hobbies and Special Interests
- \$36 Application Fee

Submitted material will be retained for future consideration for up to 3 years. Those materials will not be returned unless otherwise agreed upon in advance. Incomplete nomination forms and/or omitted required materials will automatically disqualify the nominee from consideration. Indiana Jewish Historical Society membership is not a requirement as part of consideration. **Individuals cannot nominate themselves.**

### Award determination and notification:

The Hoosier Jewish Legend Awards Committee is an ad hoc committee of the Indiana Jewish Historical Society (IJHS).

All submissions are confidential, and nominees are not notified of the application submitted or its status unless it is successful. Submitters of applications will be notified of receipt of application and contacted again directly with the results. Qualified nomination forms remain active for 3 years from the original date of submission. Awards will be presented at the IJHS Hoosier Jewish Legends - A Hall of Fame annual program in August.

Award winners will be notified by June 1 each year.

NOTE: Judges are not members of the Legends committee or the IJHS Board. They are selected from the IJHS membership and/or representatives of the Jewish communities around the state.
